
In the above subject, a 15-days safety drive is to be launched with effect from 13.05.26 to 27.05.26 to ensure the proper working condition and effectiveness of fire extinguishers provided in trains and at stations. During the safety drive, officials should pay special emphasis on the following aspects:

1. Checking of validity and expiry date of fire extinguishers.
2. Ensuring that all fire extinguishers are in proper working condition and readily available at designated locations.
3. Verification of pressure gauge, safety seal, hose pipe and nozzle condition of fire extinguishers.
4. Ensuring proper accessibility and visibility of fire extinguishers in coaches, and station premises.
5. Testing of approximately 50 fire extinguishers in trains and 25 fire extinguishers at stations in each division during the drive period.

In this drive, officers and supervisors of Mechanical, Operating, Engineering, S&T, Electrical, & Commercial departments of division may be involved. Effective action must be taken on all deficiencies and irregularities noticed in the drive.


1. Checking of validity and expiry date of fire extinguishers.
