Sub: Safety Drive on Monsoon precautions.

Ref: (i) NWR/HQ/Safety/SD/6726, Date: 22.06.2026

Safety Drive is launched with immediate effect from 24.06.2026 to 08.07.2026 for 15 days to ensure Monsoon precautions and prevent accidents due to Cyclonic Storm, Heavy Rains, Landslides etc. by involving Operating, Engineering, S&T, Mechanical and Electrical departments of JU division. Special emphasis should be given on the following points

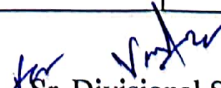
1. Availability of GPS trackers with Key men /Patrolmen may be ensured and functionality of GPS trackers may also be checked during inspections.
2. Anemometers working condition may be checked by the inspecting officials during their inspections.
3. Counseling of Station Staff regarding their duties during Monsoon.
4. Counseling of Crew regarding their duties during Monsoon.
5. Monsoon Patrolling in the Identified and vulnerable sections and posting of stationary watchmen at vulnerable locations.
6. Special precautions in areas prone to Landslide, Hill Slip, Boulder Falling etc.
7. Adequate measures may be taken when the advance warning from Indian meteorological department is received about Cyclonic Storms, Deep Depression and Heavy Rainfall etc.
8. Identification of new/ additional vulnerable points.
9. Motor trolley / Push trolley inspection by headquarter / divisional officers and supervisors.
10. Prevention of Track Circuiting failure due to water logging.
11. Adjustment of Track Circuits parameters to keep track relay pickup voltage within safety limit.
12. Functioning of Wipers, Air Dryers, Roof Clamps and Sanding Gears including filling of Sand on Locomotives, EMUs and DMUs.
13. Frequent and intensive foot plate inspection of the vulnerable sections especially during night.
