Sub: 15-Day Safety Drive regarding movement of Train with Electric Locomotives during Power Blocks.

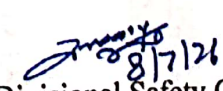
(ii) Incident of Rail Special with Electric Locomotive in Power Block section at Daurai (DOZ) Yard, Ajmer Division on 04.07.2026.

In view of the above-referred incident, a 15-day Safety Drive shall be launched from 09.07.2026 to 23.07.2026 involving the Operating, Electrical, Engineering and S&T Departments at the Divisional levels. During the Safety Drive, officers and supervisors of the concerned departments shall pay special emphasis to the following aspects:

1. Ensure that no train hauled by an Electric Locomotive is permitted to enter any section under power block without obtaining proper clearance from the concerned TRD official.
2. Ensure that no train is permitted to enter any section under Traffic block without obtaining proper clearance from the concerned official.
3. Ensure strict compliance with all prescribed procedures governing power blocks/Traffic Blocks and train operations within the affected section.
4. Ensure proper exchange of Private Numbers (PN), acknowledgement of Power Block/Traffic Block messages, and accurate recording of all relevant particulars in station records.
5. Verify that Station Masters, Controllers, Traction Power Controllers (TPCs), TRD, S&T and P-Way officials have a clear understanding of the limits and conditions of the power block/ Traffic Blocks before permitting any train movement.
6. Ensure adequate protection of the power block/Traffic Blocks section by displaying the prescribed signals, indicators, caution boards, stop collar and PLA card wherever applicable.
7. Conduct surprise inspections by officers and supervisors during power blocks/Traffic Blocks to verify compliance with laid-down procedures.
8. Conduct intensive counselling of Station Masters, Controllers, Loco Pilots, Pointsman, TRD, S&T and P-Way staff and other concerned staff.
9. Any deficiency or unsafe practice noticed during inspections shall be rectified immediately.
10. Officers and supervisors shall closely monitor the implementation of the Safety Drive and ensure strict compliance at all stations, yards and maintenance locations.
